
This fabric was printed with the free Inklingo shape collection. It could have been printed lighter or darker with other colors of ink. Even dark fabrics are usually light enough on the wrong side to print.

Fabric prints just like paper when it is stabilized with freezer paper and the freezer paper can be re-used many times.

Love the lines. Quilt more.

Inklingo is a precise, simple way to prepare shapes for machine piecing, hand piecing and appliqué.



The free shape collection makes it easy to get started. Print a contrasting fabric with the same shapes as this one and make two star blocks for Tilde's Tiny Tote (free pattern).

This is a "combo" layout. The free shape collection can print triangles, diamonds, and squares separately too, of course.
